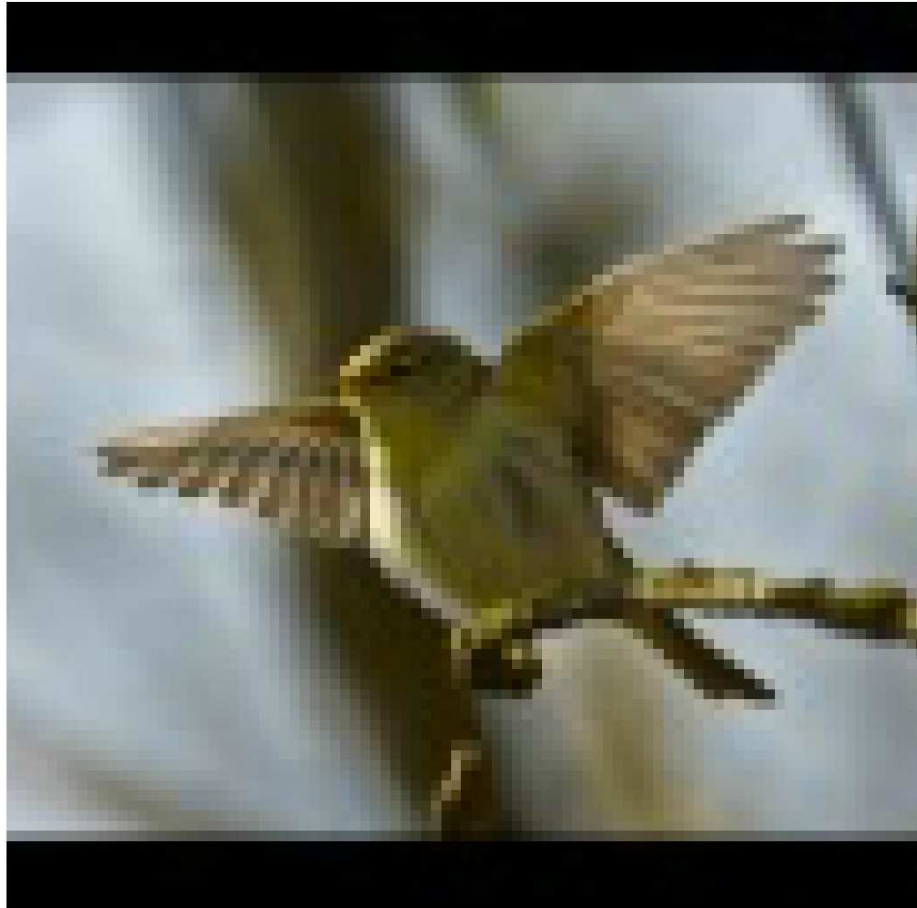


CURIOSITIES OF ANIMAL LIFE

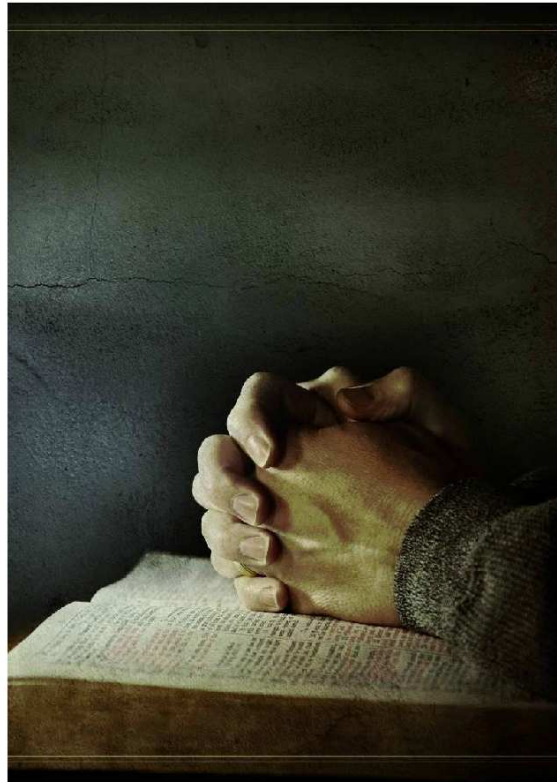
